



SEED LIBRARY POLICY

Taking seeds:

- In an effort to provide seeds to as many patrons as possible we ask that you take no more than 1 envelope of each seed variety that is desired, and a maximum of 5 seed packets.
- Our staff are not plant experts and may or may not be able to answer any questions about using seeds or about the plants that grow from them.

Using seeds:

- Use of seeds is at your own risk, the Library is not responsible for any problems encountered using the seeds or plants.
- You may receive some seeds that don't germinate.
- Some seeds and/or plants are toxic to people or pets. Please use caution!

Donating / Returning seeds:

- We ask that you donate seeds back to the Library when possible, using our Seed Donation form.
- Only donate seeds from plants from which you know how to properly harvest seeds and have done so.
- We accept seeds from other plants, labelled properly.
- No Cannabis nor any other seeds that may be illegal in local jurisdictions should be donated.
- Donations may be refused or disposed of at the discretion of the Library.

Use of our seed library constitutes agreement to the terms of this policy.
